Things to Bring with You*:

- Car Seat** You're Currently Using (we can't help you without a seat) **NO FEE to get your seat checked!**
- Child or Children*** (unless you're pregnant**)
- Picture ID** (driver's license, id card, military id, etc.)
- Proof of Low Income** (Medical Coupon, WIC Book, Food Stamp Card, etc.) **if new seat is determined to be needed by Car Seat Clinic Staff**
- Cash or Check** (Fee varies from \$20 and up per seat) **Payment MUST be made when you get your seat** **FEE is required to be collected at the time you receive your new seat!**

***We are unable to assist you with a new seat if your child(ren) are not with you!**

****We Can't Assist Expecting Parents Obtain a Reduced-Priced Car Seat through our program; However, we CAN assist you with the installation of your car seat!**

NO Aftermarket Products are Allowed to be ATTACHED to a Car Seat. Handle, Strap, etc.

Harness is too High (Must Be BELOW Shoulders when Rear-Facing)
NOTE: Harness should be ABOVE Shoulders when Car Seat is Forward-Facing

Harness Clip is too Low (Must be at Armpit Level)

Please Note:
Each Seat Check can take about 30 minutes, so be prepared for some waiting time.
